# 2024 APPLICATION INFORMATION FOR THE "Bill and Joe Lawrence Scholarship"

# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Tar Heel Chapter of the ITPA has been awarding scholarships to college-bound students for nearly 25 years. Tar Heel Chapter scholarships are available to family members of active chapter members.

In earlier years, students received awards from separately funded Tar Heel Chapter scholarships, all of which were merged in recent years into the Bill and Joe Lawrence Scholarship fund. Bill and Joe both worked for Heins Telephone Company. (The family of Isabelle Heins Lawrence, Bill's wife, founded Heins Telephone Company.) Bill and Joe were dedicated Pioneers, and they established a fund that helps our Tar Heel Chapter continue awarding annual scholarships.

The scholarship is awarded annually to a college-bound student who is related to an active Tar Heel Chapter Pioneer. Tar Heel Pioneers who are pursuing a degree are also eligible. The scholarship check will be issued directly to the college or university in which the recipient is enrolled.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Tar Heel Chapter members and families of members are eligible to apply. Pioneer members (regular, associate, auxiliary, or life member) must be current on their annual membership dues for 2024 to apply or to sponsor an applicant. The scholarship applicant must be enrolled in a graduate or undergraduate program in any field at an accredited college or university and must have maintained a 3.0 GPA for the most recently completed year (high school or college.)

#### **APPLICATION**

All applicants must complete the attached application and provide all additional information (letters of recommendation, transcripts, etc.) to the Chairman of the club's scholarship committee directly, by e-mail or by U.S. mail with a **postmark date no later than August 1, 2024.** Incomplete applications will not be considered. The scholarship committee will evaluate all eligible applications and decisions of the committee are final.
