

The Andy Griffith Show was based on Andy Griffith's hometown of Mount Airy, NC. From Floyd's Barber Shop to fried pork chop sandwiches, Mount Airy has embraced its role as the inspiration for Mayberry. Our annual assembly will be held a stone's throw from Mayberry (Mount Airy) in Dobson, NC.

Both towns are located in Surry County. Mount Airy is actually much larger than rural Dobson, although Dobson is the county seat of Surry County. Dobson is also the home of the Shelton Vineyards, the largest winery in North Carolina. You'll enjoy the laid back feel of both Dobson and Mount Airy, and we we'll do our best to ensure you enjoy this Mayberry assembly. If you fly in to attend, the Piedmont Triad International Airport in Greensboro is only a little over an hour's drive to the hotel in Dobson.

Hampton Inn—Dobson Location of ITPA's 32nd Annual Assembly



Located in the Yadkin Valley at 150 Charlestowne Drive, the Hampton Inn & Suites in Dobson, NC features an indoor pool, free bike rentals and rooms with a 27-inch flat-screen TV. Elkin Creek Vineyard is a 20-minute drive away. Every room includes a

microwave, refrigerator and coffee maker, with free Wi-Fi. A hot continental breakfast is served daily. The hotel also features a fitness center and a fully equipped business center on site.

Cody Park is a 15-minute drive and Mayberry Mall is just 20 minutes away. Stone Mountain State Park is less than an hour's drive. Pilot Mountain State Park is 25 minutes from the hotel. The park includes the distinctive 2,241 ft. peak of Pilot Mountain, shown below.

The hotel is currently undergoing renovations and will be beautifully remodeled when we arrive. Our rooms are already blocked and everyone is encouraged to make your reservations early online at

Click on "Special Rates" and under Group Code enter "ITPA."

To make reservations by phone call Jennie Lee at 336-353-9400, ext. 2122 and be sure to mention the "ITPA" special group rate.

The standard room rate is \$145 per night and includes either one king bed (roll-away available) or 2 queens. A studio, which is slightly larger is available for \$10 more. (Luxury rooms are significantly larger than standard rooms and include a kitchenette for \$175 per night.) Check-in time is 3PM.

Where to Eat

Mount Airy has quite a few delicious restaurants. Here are just a few:



Snappy Lunch has been around since the 1920s and it's pretty much the same as when Andy Griffith ate there while growing up in Mount Airy. The restaurant is famous for its pork chop sandwich, Mayberry aficionados may recognize the name from an early

episode of "The Andy Griffith Show" where Andy suggested to Barney that they go to the Snappy Lunch. Located at 206 N Main Street, the restaurant is open for breakfast and lunch Monday through Saturday.

Aunt Bea's Barbeque at 452 North Andy Griffith Parkway in Mount Airy serves breakfast all day and serves barbeque and burgers for lunch.

13 Bones at 502 S. Andy Griffith Parkway offers ribs, steak and seafood.

In Dobson, **Surry Diner** is open from 6am—8pm on Tuesday through Saturday (closed Sunday and Monday).

Little Italy at 310 N. White Street offers pizza and delectable Italian dishes.

Open Wednesday through Sunday, **The Depot Restaurant at Cody Creek**, 112 Old Depot Lane, offers a wide variety of options.

If you decide to take a drive over to **Pilot Mountain**, you may want to visit **Cousin Gary's Family Restaurant** on 626 South Key Street.

You can also find another **Aunt Bea's Barbeque** on 642 S. Keys Street in Mount Pilot.

Be sure to visit the Mayberry Courthouse in Mount Airy. It's a The replica of the courthouse that appeared in "The Andy Griffith Show" in the 1960s.



Visitors can sit behind Andy's desk, type on a vintage typewriter, and sit in a jell cell just like the one that appeared on the show. You can also visit the Andy Griffith Museum. If you need a haircut, visit Floyd's City Barber Shop.

There are several local wineries in the vicinity.

Old North State Winery in Mount Airy (308 North Main Street) also offers an elevated dining experience. Open Wednesday through Saturday, reservations are recommended. Visit https://oldnorthstatewinery.com.

In Pilot Mountain, visit JOLO Winery & Vineyards at 219 JOLO Winery Lane. You can also dine at this award winning winery. Visit https://www.jolovineyards.com to learn more.

In Dobson, you can visit **Shelton Vineyards**, the largest winery in North Carolina. Tours are available Monday through Saturday at noon, 2pm and 4pm and on Sunday at 3pm. To learn more, visit www.sheltonvineyards.com

What to do



Also in Dobson, you can visit Stony Knoll Vineyards, which is quite popular with wine enthusiasts. Located at 1143 Stony Knoll Road, the winery is open Monday through Saturday. Learn more at https://www.stonyknollvineyards.com.

Herrera Vineyards at 231 Vineyard Lane, family owned and operated winery, is also in Dobson. However, the restaurant and tasting room are temporarily closed as the family undertakes some large renovations. The estate on which the vineyard is located spans more than 140 acres.

In Mount Airy, visit the **Museum** of **Regional History** at 301 North Main Street, open Tuesday through Saturday from 10am to 5pm (\$6 admission fee).

Dobson and Pilot Mountain each boast a population of nearly 1,500 (no zeros missing) and Mount Airy's population is slightly over 10,500. Dobson's land mass covers a whopping 1.8 square miles. There are a large number of farms in the areas surrounding Dobson, the main crops being corn, tobacco and soy beans.

The town of Pilot Mountain was named for the landmark Pilot Mountain, which is a distinctive geological formation. The town's land mass covers 1.7 square miles.

In comparison, Mount Airy is a large town, spanning 8.4 square miles. It is one of the most populous municipalities in Surry County. Originally settled in the 1750s, Mount Airy was officially incorporated in 1885.

Fun Facts about Mount Airy:

Mount Airy has a sister city, Samut Songkhram, in Thailand.

Mount Airy hosts an Autumn Leaves Festival during the 2nd weekend in October each year, attracting more than 200,000 people.

Mounty Airy radio station WPAQ still operates as a Bluegrass and Old-Time music station and has been airing live since 1948.

Mount Airy hosts weekly bluegrass jam sessions at the Andy Griffith Playhouse.
